Subject	Strand	Unit of work title / Overview
English	<i>Reading</i>	Cosmic by Frank Cotterill Boyce
	<i>Writing</i>	We will be writing: a story from a different perspective; a letter and an explanation of how to become an astronaut.
	<i>Spelling</i>	The focus is on silent letters, ough endings and homophones.
	<i>Grammar</i>	Recap of word classes such as nouns, adjectives and conjunctions as well as parts of a sentence such as phrases and clauses.
	<i>Punctuation</i>	Sentence types, commas after clauses and inverted commas.
Maths	<i>Units of work</i>	We will read, write roman numerals up to 1000. We will consolidate our understanding of place value (read, write, order, compare, round) of numbers up to 1,000,000. We will solve number and practical problems
Science	<i>Working scientifically</i>	We will be carrying out comparative fair testing.
	<i>Units of work</i>	We will describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. We will describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth. We will describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies. We will use the idea of the rotation of the Earth to explain night and day and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky.
Spanish	<i>Units of work</i>	Planets; los planetas. Learning Spanish vocabulary for the solar system to link with our science unit this half term.
History	<i>Units of work</i>	We will be looking at the invasion and settlement of the Anglo-Saxons including when this happened, why it happened and how do we know (exploring evidence).
Art	<i>Units of work</i>	We will be developing our drawing and sketching linked to Space. We will research the artist Hiroyuki Doi. When drawing we will use a variety of techniques and experiment with tone.
Music	<i>Social question</i>	How does music bring us together?
	<i>Units of work</i>	Melody and harmony in music
RE	<i>Units of work</i>	We will learn about what Christians believe God is like, exploring key texts from the Bible, using ways of knowing that theologians use.
Computing	<i>Units of work</i>	Pupils will be developing their understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices. Learners consider small-scale systems as well as large-scale systems.
PE	<i>Units of work</i>	Invasion games focusing on different social skills each week: determination, encouragement, body language, communication.
PSHE	<i>Units of work</i>	Health and Wellbeing: How can we help in an accident or emergency?
