English	<i>Reading</i>	Tales of evolution including fiction and non-fiction.

RE	<i>Units of work</i>	Kings and Prophets – This unit focuses on what it is like to be Jewish and the covenant with God, exploring beliefs about God; about how ideas of God are expressed in stories, celebration, ritual and action; about David as a key leader in the Jewish tradition and about the prophets.
